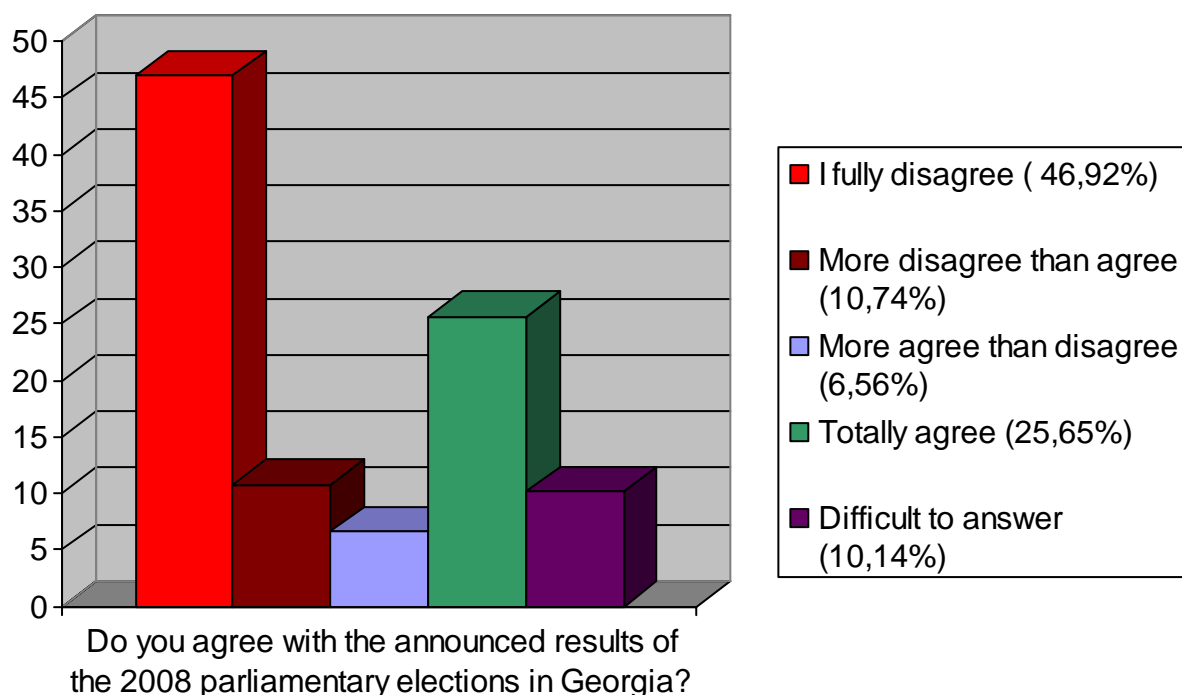


Public Opinion Survey on Current Political Processes in Georgia

in Tbilisi on 25th May, 2008)

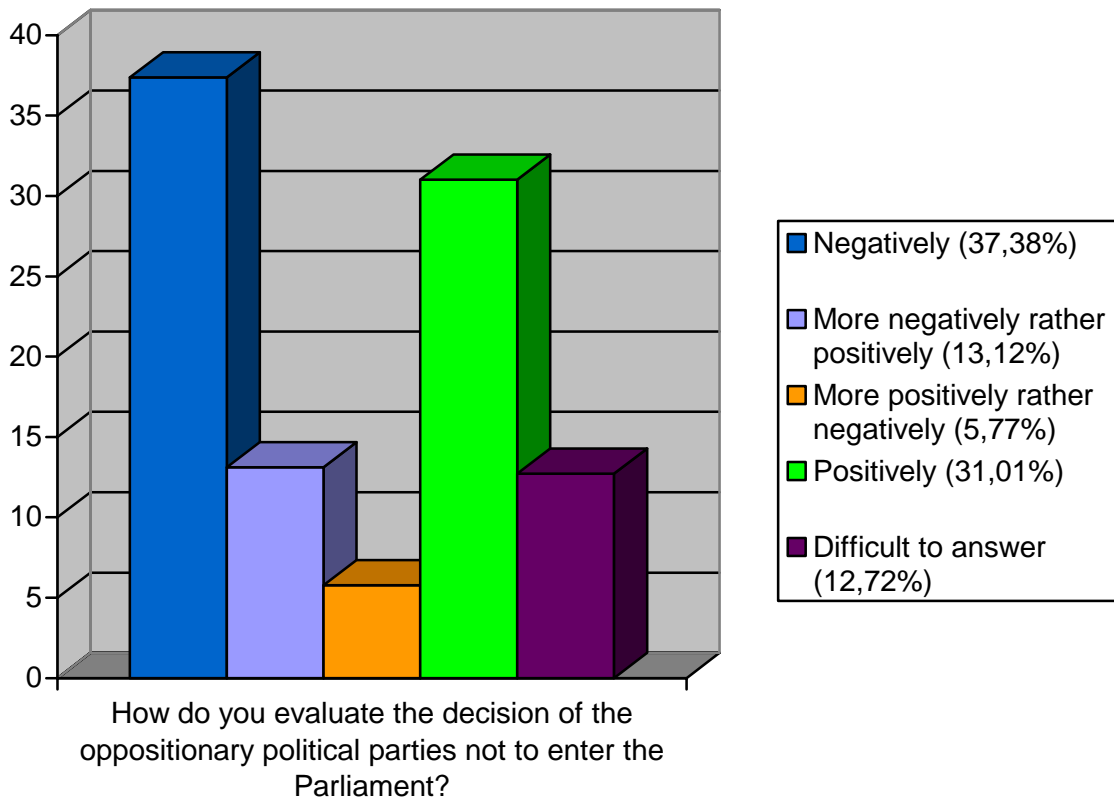
1. Do you agree with the announced results of the 2008 parliamentary elections in Georgia?

- e. Difficult to answer



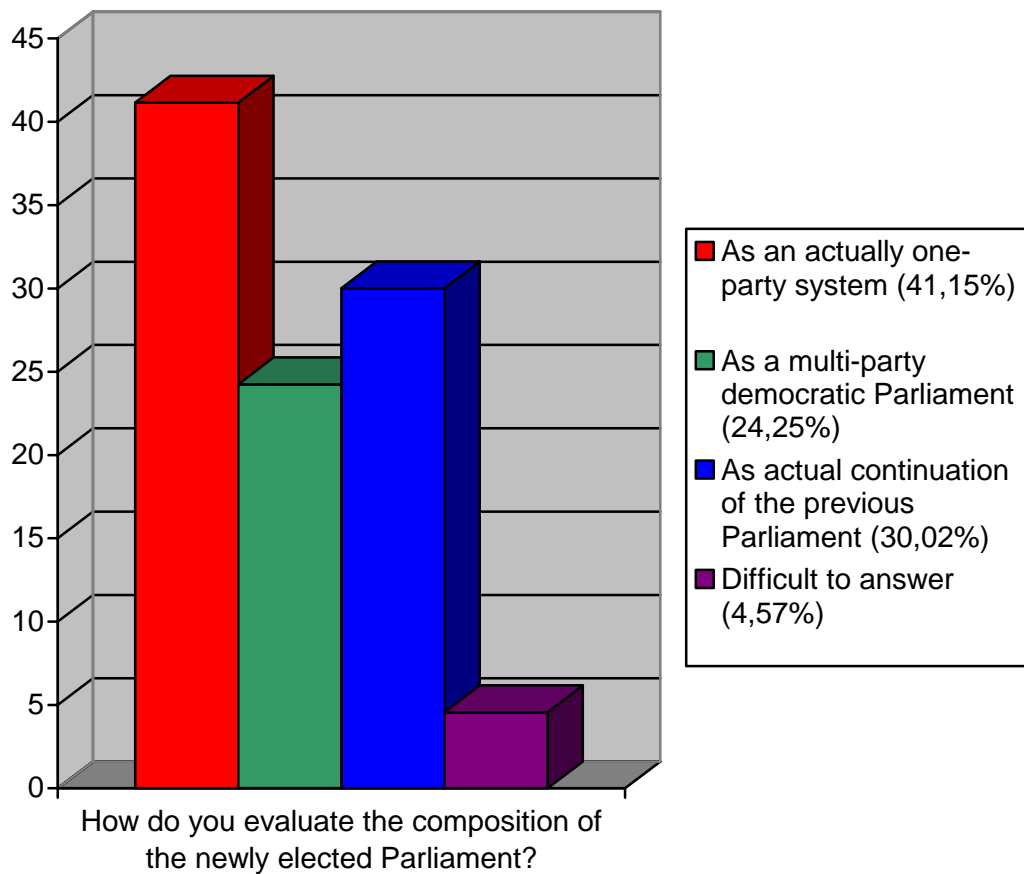
2. How do you evaluate the decision of the oppositionary political parties not to enter the Parliament?

- e. Difficult to answer



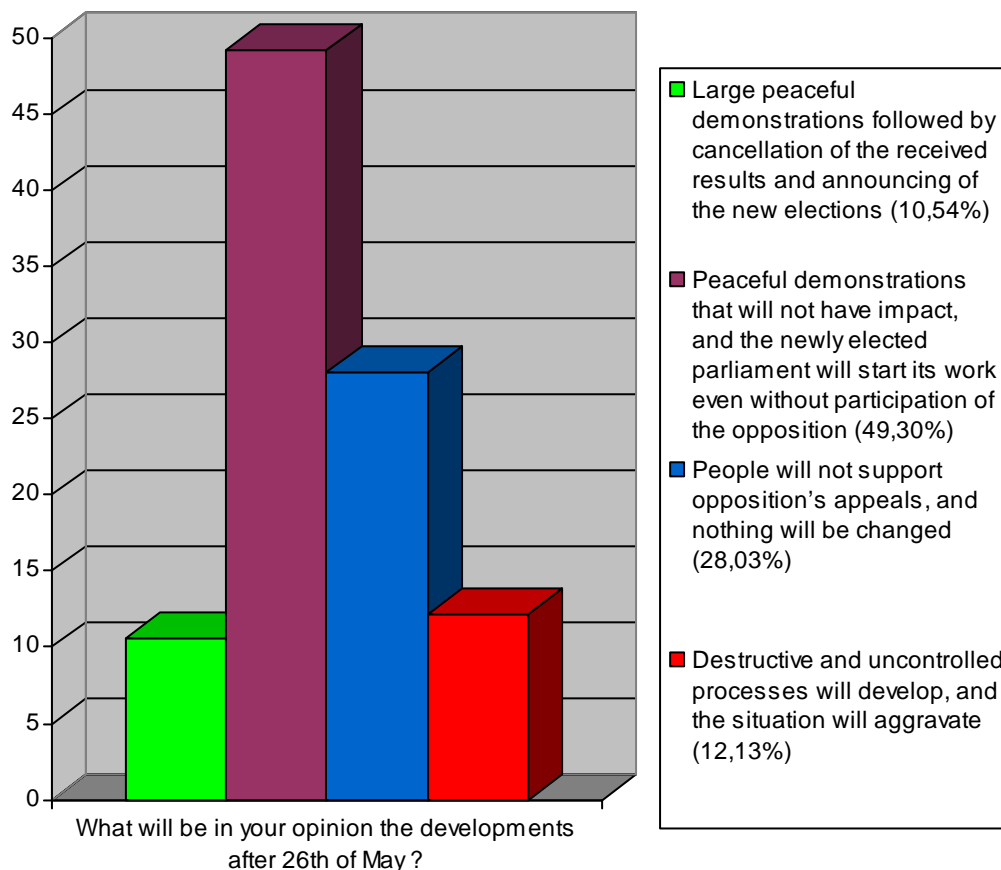
3. How do you evaluate the composition of the newly elected Parliament?
